KEYSTONE CHAPTER NEWS:

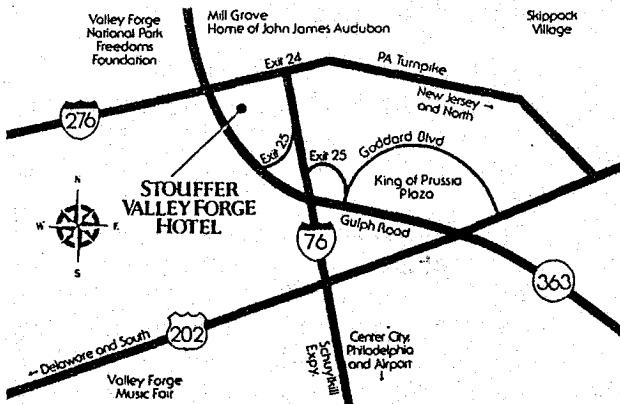

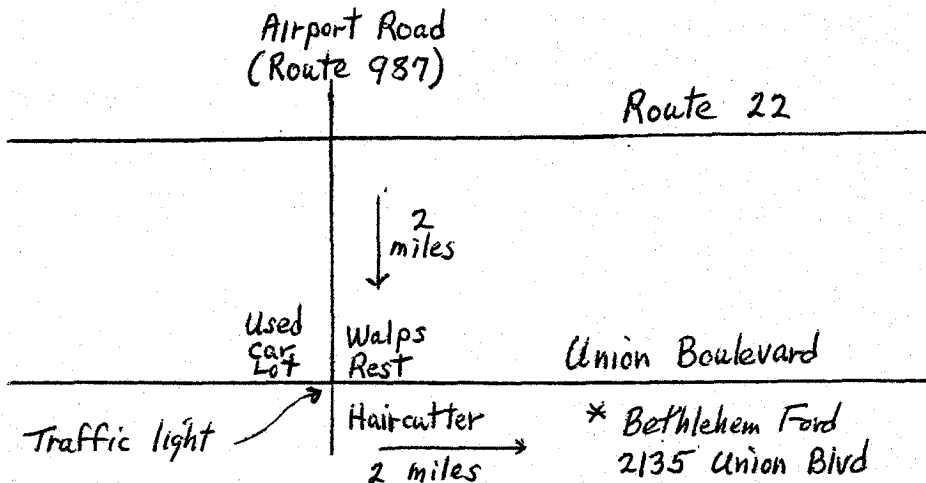
