As this leaflet is prepared, the Stouffer is being renovated, and the name will be changed to the Park Ridge at Valley Forge. 

DIRECTIONS

From I-76 (Schuylkill Expressway) take Exit 25, Goddard Blvd. Turn right at 1st & 2nd lights onto 363 N. We are located about 3/4 miles on the right.

From Turnpike take Exit 24-Valley Forge Exit, First right after toll booth. We are located on the right.

From 202 North, turn left at Rt. 363 N. (Gulph Rd.). We are approximately 1 mile on the right.

Swimming is available in the Stouffer pool during normal hours of operation.

The Stouffer Hotel runs a free shuttle bus between the hotel and the King of Prussia Mall on the following schedule:
