TECHNICAL HELP WANTED:

On my '63 Sprint convertible, the oil fill cap is vented and for as long as I can remember, oil comes out of the breather element and is sprayed onto the underside of the hood by the fan. I was told it may be a ventilation problem so I changed the PCV valve, and that did not help. Could someone tell me why the oil, under pressure, backs up the fill tube, and is forced out the cap? The oil level on the dipstick is normal, and the cooling system is new. I would like to solve this problem so I can detail the engine compartment. Thanks for your help. 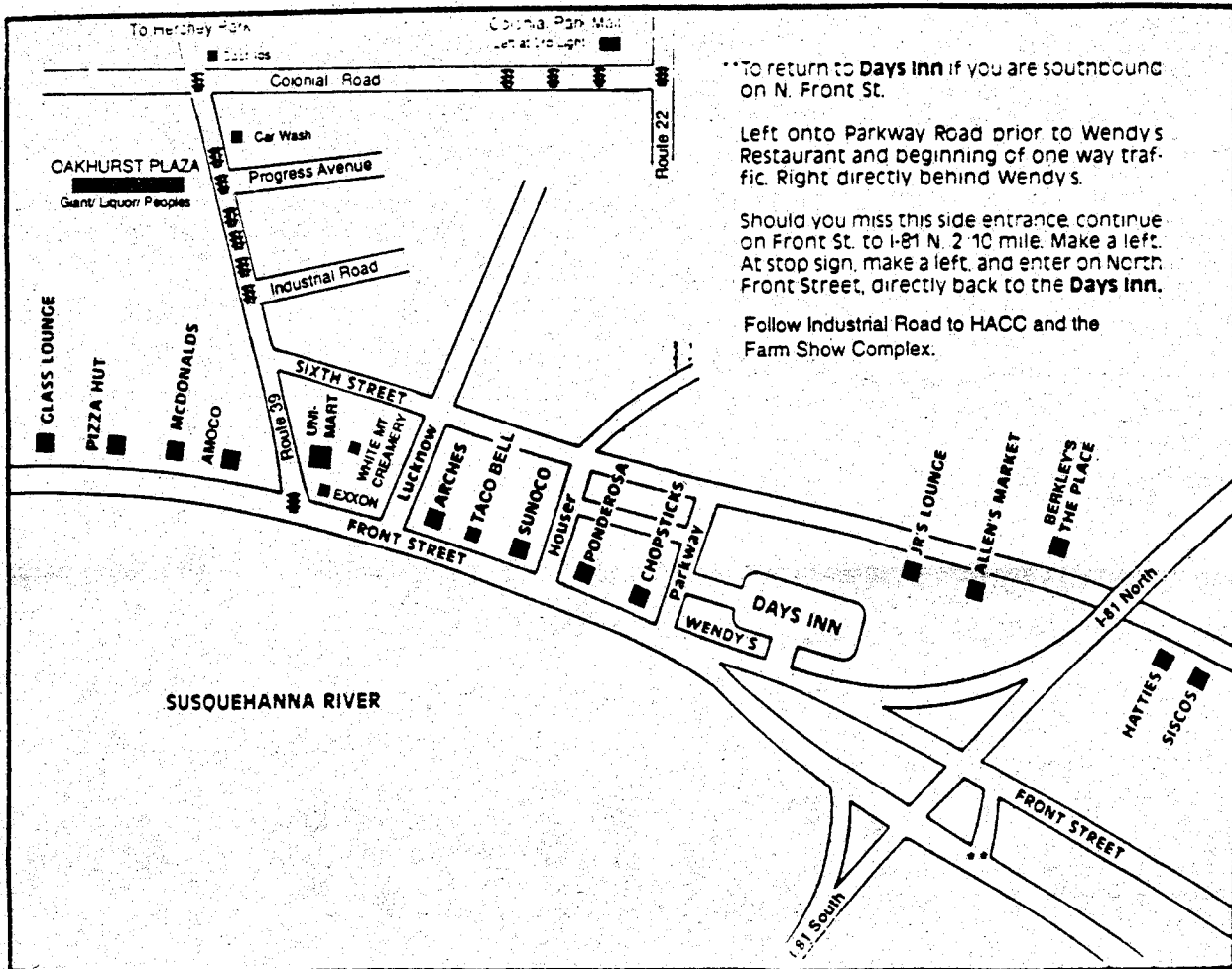
