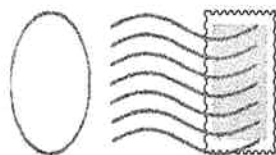

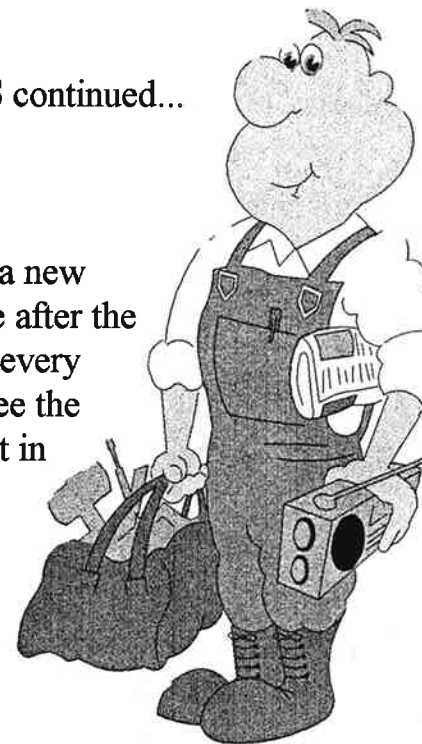

Sunday, May 18th

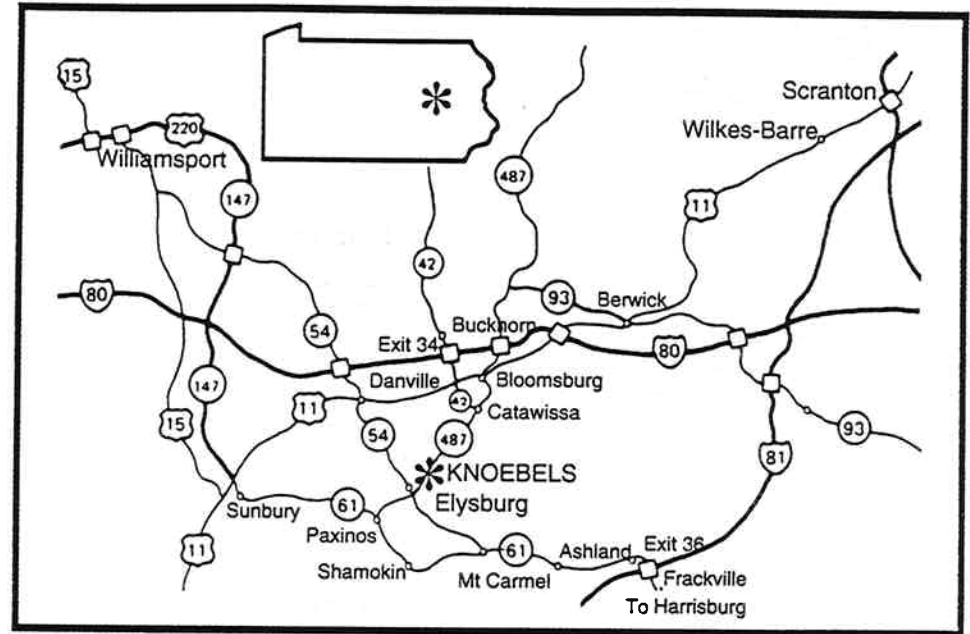


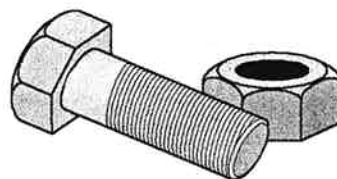
