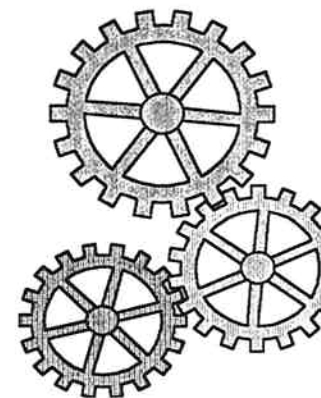

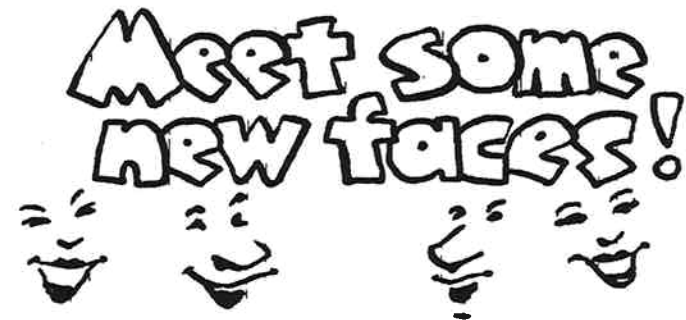

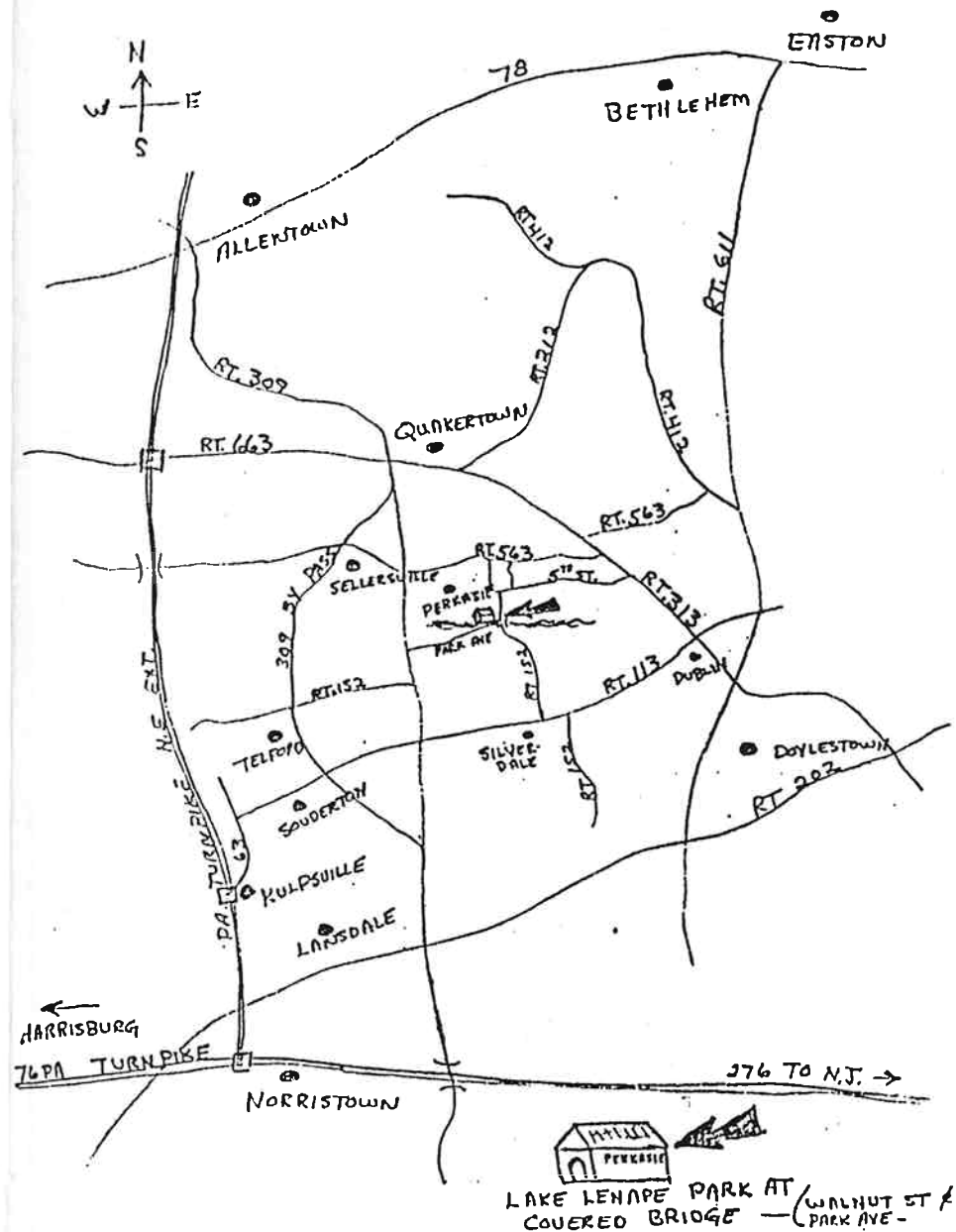


## 10th Anniversary of the Keystone Chapter

## AREA MAP: LAKE LENAPE PARK

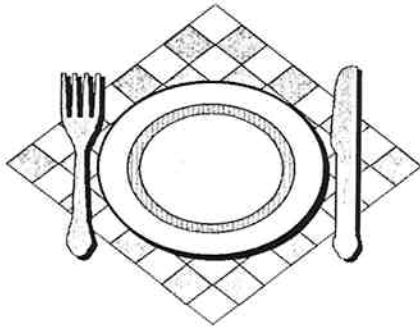


## 1998 Keystone Dinner
