SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT



I have been traveling to a lot of National and Regional meets the last 10 years or so and one thing that makes the trip better is having a CB radio to communicate with the rest of the convoy. It only takes a few minutes to install after the initial installation.

I got an extra Falcon ashtray and mounted it to my CB radio bracket. I connected a cigarette lighter plug to the hot line of the CB radio. I put a CB radio splitter in the radio antenna line. I have been told that the CB signal might not be as strong using an antenna splitter, as it would be with a separate CB antenna. It has always been strong enough for me. We usually use one of the lower channels on the CB. Channel 19 has all the trucker chatter.

Now when I want to install the CB, it only takes a few minutes. I remove my good ash tray and cigarette lighter, wrap them up in a small hand towel and slide the ash tray in that has the CB attached, plug the hot line into the cigarette lighter, hook the antenna to the splitter connection under the dash and I am ready for traveling. It is also easy to remove the CB and get the car ready for the show. That's a big 10-4 good Buddy, and the pedals to the medal, watch out for those Smokies.

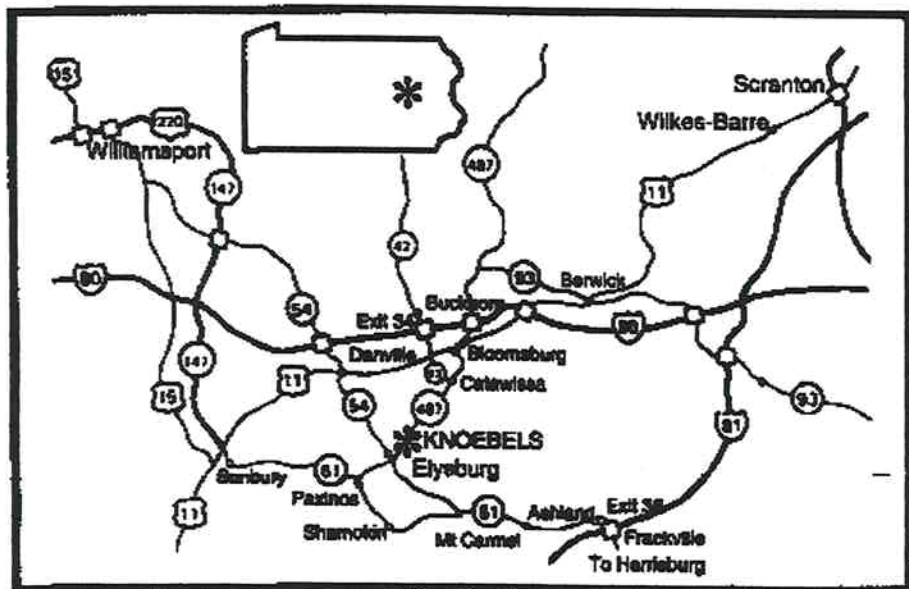
