From the PA turnpike (either direction) get off exit 18 (Harrisburg W.) Once through the tollbooth take I-83 N. Within 2-3 miles the road splits. You want to be in the right lane headed to Harrisburg. Stay in this lane. Get off at exit 42 (Lemoyne) You will automatically be headed over a railroad bridge, this is 3rd St. At the second light, make a left onto Market St. The dealership is 5 miles on the left.

If traveling I-81 (either direction) take exit 21 (Rtes. 11& 15) Take 11 & 15 S. toward Enola. You will travel 5.5 mi. thru the towns of Summerdale, Enola and W.Fairview. There will be signs indicating a right turn onto Rtes. 11&15. **DO NOT MAKE THIS TURN.** Continue Straight. This is the town of Wormleysburg. Within 2-3 mi. you will have to go left or right at the light. Make a right turn thru the "S" curve. Continue on Market St., Lemoyne. L.B. Smith is within 2-3 mi. on the left. It's a can't miss as it's the only new car dealership left in Lemoyne. NOTE: The speed limit thru Lemoyne is 25 mph.

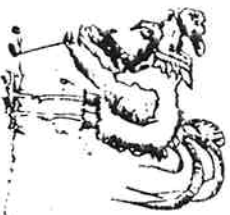
