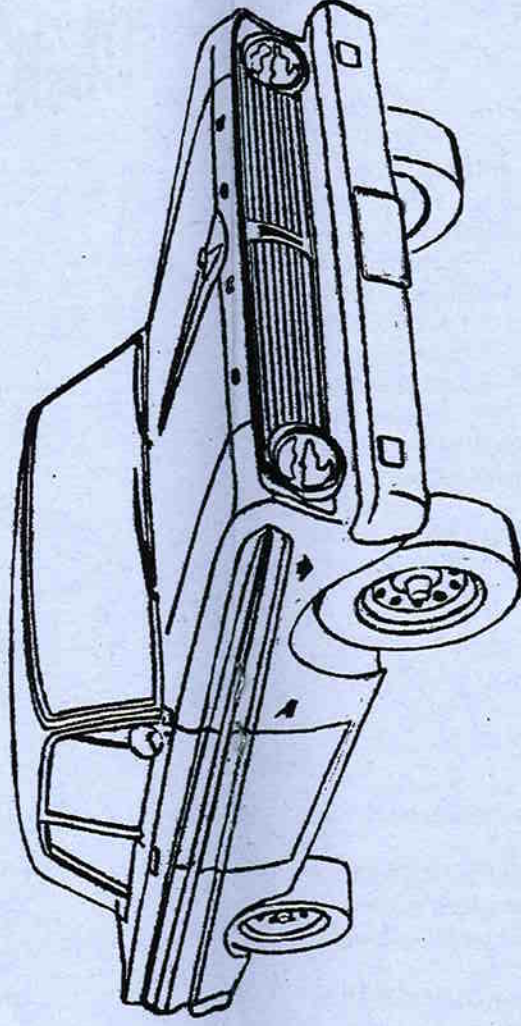

Are you familiar with these tools?
