New Location for Annual Spring Dinner Saturday April 3rd, 2004

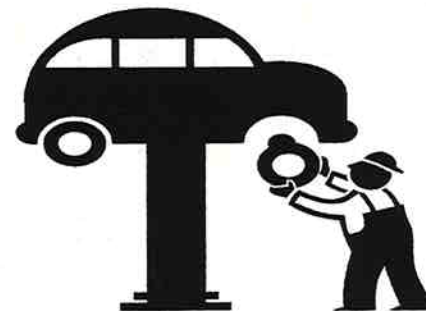

Who is that guy that started the Keystone Chapter?

In 1987 Ed Snyder of Perkasio, PA, a tool & die maker, owned 2 Falcons. These 2 Falcons were very different from each other. The Blue Bomber, a 1964 2dr sedan was used for daily transportation and for the daughters to drive. The other Falcon was a 1964 Vintage Burgundy Sprint hardtop that was taken to most shows in an enclosed trailer. The Sprint was "Better Than New" in that it took many awards including a Falcon Regional "Best of Show" and many awards in the AACA up to the "Grand National" award level. Ed's Sprint was one of the first Falcons in the Keystone Chapter to be restored to this AACA stature. Ed's Sprint also won first place in its class at the 1988 FCA National meet in Atlanta, GA. Ed was the Keystone Chapter President from 1988 to 1995. He also served as Vice President for several years. Ed and his wife Nancy still remain very active in the club. Their dedication to the club and thoughtfulness to its members are well appreciated by all in the club.
