The **MASTERS CLASS WILL REMAIN AS AACA AWARDED FALCONS WITH UP TO DATE CERTIFICATIONS.** These Falcons will be eligible for all awards. **MASTERS CLASS OWNERS HAVE THE OPTION OF ENTERING THEIR FALCONS IN THEIR RESPECTIVE CLASSES IF THEY SO CHOOSE.** They cannot be in MASTERS and their respective classes at the same show. **MASTERS CLASS MUST REGISTER FOR THAT CLASS ONE MONTH PRIOR TO THE SHOW CUT OFF DATE BECAUSE OF HAVING TO ORDER SPECIAL PLAQUES.**

This regional is the first time we are going to have non-falcon Fords entering our regional event. There will be a limited amount of 15 non-falcons admitted to the show. Anyone wishing to enter a Ford product between the mfg. years of 1960 to 1970 should use our regional forms

and placing non-Falcon on the registration form. Three trophies will be presented to the non-falcon entrants.
