MASTERS CLASS OWNERS HAVE THE OPTION OF ENTERING THEIR FALCONS IN THEIR RESPECTIVE CLASSES IF THEY SO CHOOSE. They cannot be in MASTERS and their respective classes at the same show. MASTERS CLASS MUST REGISTER FOR THAT CLASS ONE MONTH PRIOR TO THE SHOW CUT OFF DATE BECAUSE OF HAVING TO ORDER SPECIAL PLAQUES.

This regional is the first time we are going to have non-falcon Fords entering our regional event. There will be a limited amount of 15 non-falcons admitted to the show. Anyone wishing to enter a Ford product between the mfg. years of 1960 to 1970 should use our regional forms

and placing non-Falcon on the registration form. Three trophies will be presented to the non-falcon entrants.
