Frank Servas Jr. of Center Valley, PA sent this bit of history concerning Ford Falcons. Thanks for the input Frank. His '65 was the winner of the President's Award and the Best Paint Award at the recent Lancaster show.

Ford Falcons were produced from 1960 to 1970 1/2. Station wagons were manufactured in each year of Falcon production. Rounded-fender styles were produced from 1960 through 1963. The style was changed to squared fenders in 1964 and 1965. Rounded-fender Falcons were produced again from 1966 through 1970, with the 1970 1/2 Falcons much larger in size than the previous Falcons.

The Falcon station wagon was available in four body styles in both 1964 and 1965, and the two years are close in appearance. In 1964, the 2-door wagon was available only as a standard wagon (no chrome trim). The 4-door wagon was available as a standard wagon, a deluxe wagon (with chrome trim), and a Squire wagon (with woodgrain decals and with fiberglass trim). The 1965 lineup was essentially the same, with the exception that the deluxe 4-door station wagon was now a Futura model.

I have driven Ford Falcons since 1965 and have always liked station wagons. My first car was a 1961 2-door Falcon station wagon (I no longer have this car), and my second car was a 1964 2-door Falcon station wagon (I do have this one).

Ford Falcons did not have many options available. In 1965, the base engine was either a 170 or 200 cu inch 6 cylinder (depending on model) with a 3-speed standard transmission. Power steering and power brakes were options, as well as air conditioning and some enhancements in safety.



The station wagon featured at the ISWC show is a 1965 Ford Falcon Squire station wagon. I am the third owner of this wagon. The original owner purchased the wagon from a dealer in Haddonfield, New Jersey, and later moved to Maryland. This is the top of the line Falcon station wagon and was factory equipped with a 289 engine, C4 automatic transmission, power steering, AM radio and white sidewall tires. The window sticker shows a total price of \$3,132.27. Two options, side-view mirror and wheel covers were added by the purchaser, bringing the new total to \$3,154.93. The purchaser did not trade a used car and was given a discount bringing the amount due to \$2,740.66.

The second owner purchased the car from the original owner in Maryland in 1993, and brought it to Pennsylvania. This owner started to restore the wagon but gave up before it was completed. I purchased the wagon in pieces in 1996, and it remained in pieces until 2000.

A friend from the Falcon club, Chet Wisneski, took the wagon in 2000 and worked on it until it was completed in 2003. During the restoration, some factory-available options were added including backup lights, courtesy light group, 2-speed windshield wiper and washer, remote-control mirror, padded dash, and padded visors. Squire wagons came from the factory with a power tailgate window, and this was retained. The wagon was repainted the factory color called Vintage Burgundy. The engine, transmission, and power steering components were rebuilt, and most suspension, steering, and brake components were replaced with NOS parts.

Since 2003, the Squire wagon has won AACA 1st Junior and Senior awards and was presented with The Chocolate Town Trophy at the AACA Annual Awards Banquet in February 2005. At the Keystone Chapter Regional meet in 2004, the wagon won awards for best in utility class, ladies' choice, and best of show. Most recently, it was shown at the Regional meet sponsored by the Mason-Dixon Chapter of The Falcon Club of America on August 13, 2005 in Edgewood MD. There were 49 Falcons present at this event, including sedans, hardtops, convertibles, station wagons, and rancheros. The wagon won first place in the utility class, best stock car, ladies' choice, and best of show. The wagon was purchased new by the original owner on August 13, 1965, so this show occurred exactly 40 years to the day that the wagon was purchased new.

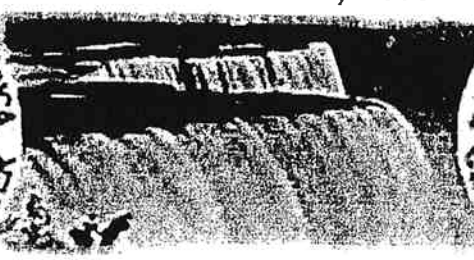
