We will be meeting then cruising to the oldest operating cave in PA, Crystal Cave, in Kutztown PA. We will start the day at 10am meeting for breakfast at Cracker Barrel Resturant in Hamburg, PA. At about 11:30 we will be leaving and cruising to Crystal Cave. This trip is about 15 miles and will take no more then 30 minutes. At 12:30 we will have a group guided tour of the cave. There will be a fee for the tour. The cost is \$7.00 for adults and \$5.50 for children under 12. These are group rate prices. We will need a minimum of 15 people to get this rate. The tour is about 45min. long. After the tour we will gather at the picnic facilities on location. There is a small food and ice cream stand on location.
