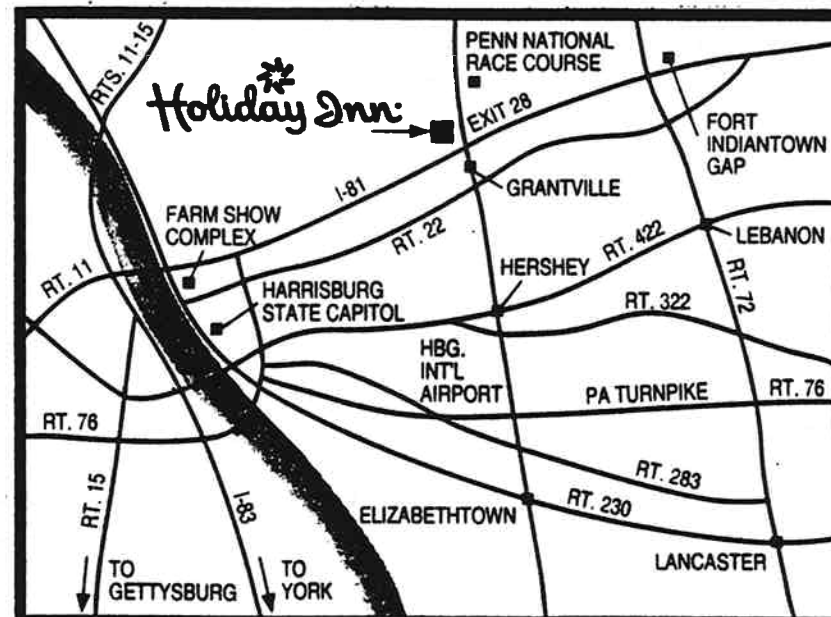

TECHNICAL TIP:

Are you having trouble with oil being thrown out from the breather cap on the valve cover? If so, here is an easy solution. First, take an old sock (with a hole in it). Cut the elastic off the top of the sock, and place that part over the breather. This will not allow oil to be thrown out over the motor or underneath the hood. Change periodically.

It is called the Ignitor and it is a screw-in replacement for the outdated points and condenser concept. The Ignitor Kit consists of a Ford Rotor, Reluctor, Pickup and attachment hardware. Drop it in, set the reluctor/pickup air gap to 0.030-inch, and the job is done.
