This message will be for all Keystone members except Ed Snyder. Ed will be getting a different message in his newsletter.

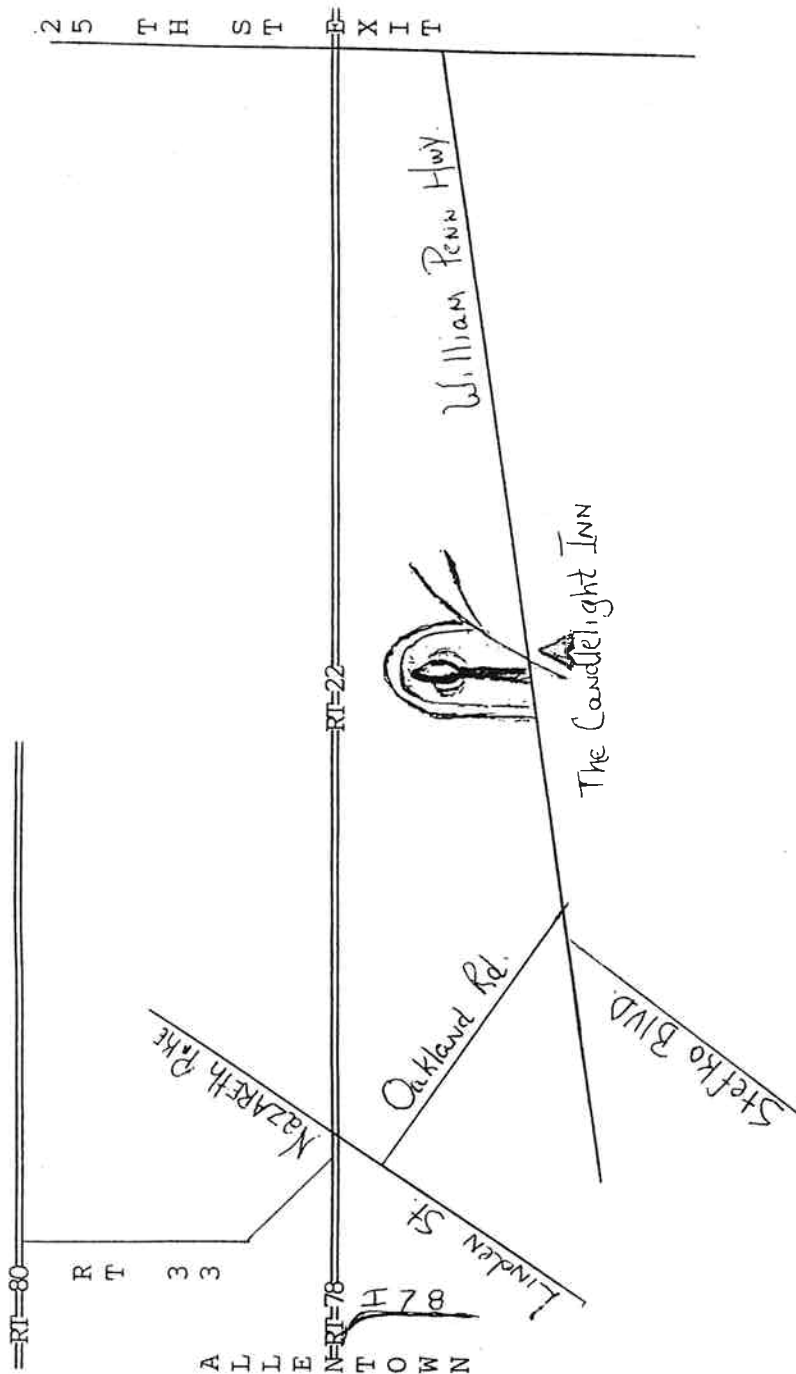

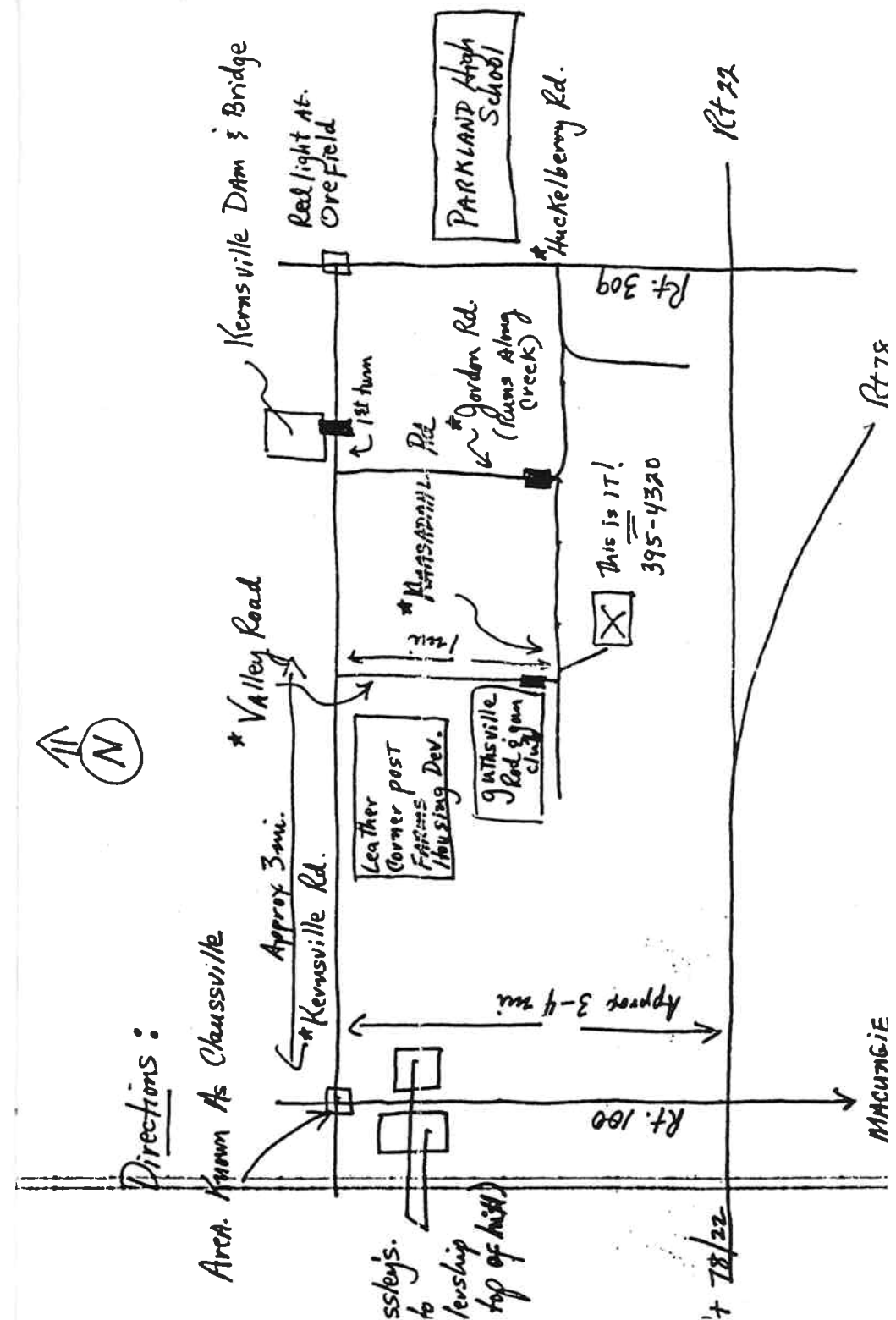
