# Marshall Hess's 1965 Modified Ranchero

In 2004 I had a partial restoration done, which included a new motor, transmission, 9" rear. The shock towers were removed and a mustang II front end installed. The front clip was restored but the rest of the truck was not.

In 2013 I decided it was time to do a complete restoration. Joe Miller at Miller Collision & Restoration in Brickerville did the work. He completely dismantled and stripped the truck of paint. The body was straightened and some rust spots fixed. I replaced the all weather stripping, windshield, seats, headliner and carpet. I had the color changed from green to blue.

The drive train is a 351 stroked to 427ci with 475 horse power, Tremec TKO 600 five speed. It has a 9" rear end with 390 Richmond gears.

# Here is a tech tip from our new member Mark Martin

Bruce, below is the link to the <u>fuel filler funnel</u> I am using on my 1964 Futura convertible. It's sold on ebay for about \$9. I used it on the way home from the LB Smith Ford meet to get gas and again I had absolutely no problem filling the tank...no drip or anything. Now, I still inserted the pump gently but this time I did pump the gas faster than I have in the past and it was fine. I'm not sure this funnel will help with overspill when the tank is full though. I don't let it get to that point, only fill up so many gallons. This funnel would probably be a good thing to put out there to the club members. It definitely works!
