Hats off to the Music City Chapter.

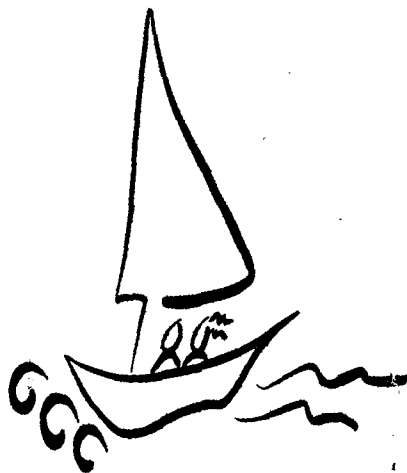

A special award was omitted in the last newsletter. Craig Pheasant, a Keystone Member, received a “Celebrity Pick” award at the 2002 Carlisle All Ford Nationals. Craig’s white 1963 Sprint Convertible was chosen by our own FCA Regional Director, Chet Wisneski. This was Craig’s first showing at Carlisle. Craig has had his Sprint since 1964. His Falcon was seen on the drag strip in the late 60s and early 70s doing the quarter in 12 seconds at 108 MPH. You are invited to the “KEYSTONE 2002”. It is the Keystone Chapter’s 11th Regional meet. We would like to save a space for you & your Falcon. No matter what your Falcon looks like, we have a category for you. If you can’t bring your Falcon, come and join the fun. We would love to see some pictures of your car.

Join us Friday night at 6:00 for a cruise to the Kaufman Chicken Bar-B-Q restaurant and miniature golf course. Saturday will be filled with lots of “Falcon Fun”. Registration is from 8:00 AM to 11:00AM. Voting on all the Falcons will be from 11AM to 1:00 PM. There will be plenty of “Car Games” going on throughout the day. We will have a meeting in the parking lot at 3:30 PM. Finish off the day at the “Awards Banquet” at 6:30 PM for an all you can eat family style meal at the Midway Diner. If you have a Falcon, you won’t want to miss this grand party.

Below are the “KEYSTONE 2002 ” Falcon Categories. Choose one that best describes your Falcon. Choose the correct category. The voters will be the final judge if you put your Falcon in the wrong category. You know best where it belongs. Come and join the fun. Where else can you go and just talk about your favorite car?

PURE STOCK

The cars in this category should be as close to stock as possible. When you look at these cars there should be no obvious modifications that were not available from Ford. It should be 95 to 100 % stock. These cars should be the stock Ford colors and have stock interiors & engines. The owners in this category want to keep their cars as STOCK as “Henry Ford” would have liked them. The cars in this class should look like they would fit in the new car line-up at a Ford dealership back in the 60’s.

LIGHT MODIFIED

The cars in this category are some what changed from stock by the owners. These cars are not changed enough to be in the Heavy Modified Category, but are not pure stock. They might have small changes that make them different from the original Falcons. Mag wheels, extra chrome in the engine compartment, a new modern stereo system, are some examples of a Light Modified car. At a glance, these cars look stock, but when you look closer, you will see the owner’s minor changes to personalize this Falcon.

HEAVY MODIFIED

These Falcons have a changed look from the word **GO!!!** There is no mistake when you look at these cars that some major modifications took place in the development of these cars. They might have different paint schemes, major modifications to the engine compartment or interior. Some of these cars have modifications to make them fly faster than the stock birds.

ROUGH DRIVER

These cars could be in the very early stages of being restored. Just as the Category name states, these cars are “ROUGH”. They could be a daily driver that needs a total restoration. When you look at these cars it is obvious that almost nothing has been done to restore them to original condition. This class is for the people that want to enter their car in the Regional meet but don’t have the time or money right now to complete their car. Everyone likes seeing these cars at the meets. We can then watch them progress over the years and eventually move into the other categories.

All classes will be determined by pre-registration on August 4th.

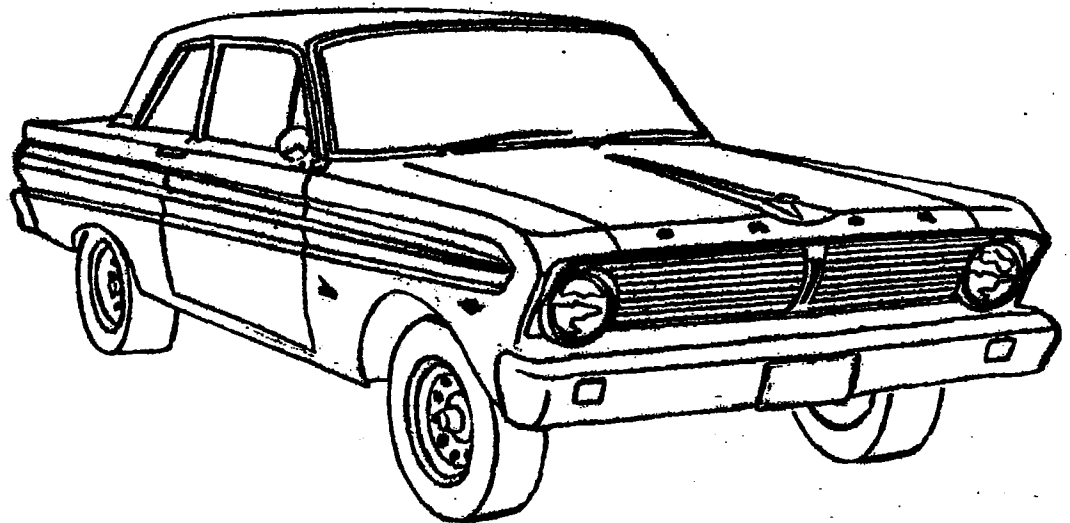

From the PA turnpike (either direction) get off exit 18 (Harrisburg W.) Once through the tollbooth take I-83 N. Within 2-3 miles the road splits. You want to be in the right lane (or continue on I-83) headed to Harrisburg. Stay in this lane and get off at the 2nd exit, number 42 (this is the **old** exit #), **Lemoyne**. At the end of the exit you will be forced to bear right over a bridge, you will now be on 3rd Street. At the second light, make a left onto Market St. **LB Smith Ford** is 1/2 mile on the left.

If traveling I-81 (either direction) take exit 21 (this is the **old** exit number), Rtes. 11 & 15. **Take 11 & 15 S. toward Enola**. This road will parallel the river. You will travel ~~several miles through the towns of Summerdale, Enola and W. Fairview.~~ There will be signs indicating a right turn onto Rtes. 11 & 15. **DO NOT MAKE THIS TURN.** Continue straight. This is the town of Wormleysburg. Within a mile or two you will have to go left or right at the light. Make a right turn (left turn goes over river to Harrisburg) thru the "S" curve. Continue on Market St. **LB Smith Ford** is within 1 mile on the left. It's a can't miss as it's the only new car dealership left in Lemoyne.

NOTE: The speed limit through Lemoyne is 25 mph.
