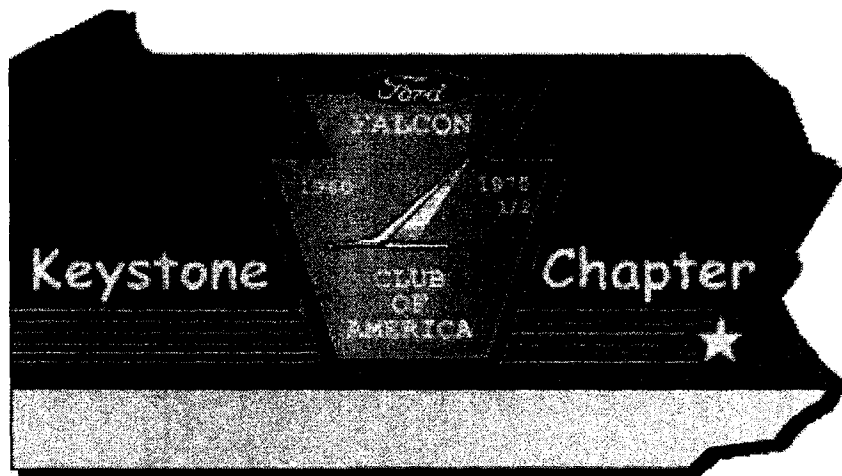

## *President's Message*

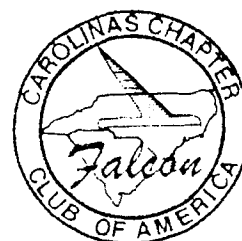

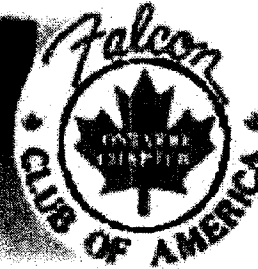
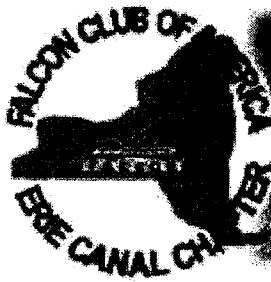
