MEMORIAL LAKE FALCON PICNIC — **MAY 22ND**

We will picnic from 11AM to 3PM. The park office address is 18 Boundary Road, Grantville, PA 17028. We will use the Lower Road picnic area about 2 miles from Exit 85 of I-81. Everyone will bring their own lunch. We will park our Falcons together. There are plenty of picnic tables spread out under the trees. There are also 2 bar-b-que grills at this picnic location. Bring charcoal and aluminum foil if you want to use the grills. There will be 2 personal kayaks to use on the lake. 1 single kayak and 1 two person kayak. Paddles and life preservers will be supplied also. They will be available at 10:00am. There is also a boat/kayak rental at the park. Come early if you like and check out the lake on a kayak. You can also take a nice walk around the lake, about 2 miles, on the beautiful trails.

At 3:00 PM we will leave Memorial Lake and cruise to the close by Indiantown Gap National Cemetery and the Indiantown Gap Military Reservation. There is a display of helicopters and tanks to check out. There is a rare display of a 40&8 "Gratitude Box Car" that was a gift from the people of France and given to the American people in 1949. 40&8 stood for 40 soldiers or 8 horses. They gave one boxcar to each of the 48 states with the territory of Hawaii and DC sharing the 49th boxcar. Check out more information here. https://www.themetrains.com/merci-train-main.htm

At 4:00 PM we will leave Indiantown Gap and head to the Lickdale Campground and General Store for ice cream (about 3 mi.—11 Lickdale Rd. Jonestown, PA 17038). The store is located at exit 90 of I-81. If you can't make it to the picnic come at 3:00 for the cruise or meet us at Lickdale for ice cream.

DIRECTIONS TO THE PARK (Lower Road) FROM EXIT 85 OF I-81

Take rt 934 (Fisher Ave.) towards Indiantown Gap. There are plenty of signs to guide you to Memorial Lake State Park. You will go by the entrance to the Indiantown Gap National Cemetery on the right. Turn left (1/2 mile) on to Asher Miner Rd at the Snitz Creek Restaurant. At the bottom of the hill bear left onto Boundary Road. Continue on Boundary Road past Upper Road, Middle Road, the Park Office and a church to Lower Road. Turn left onto Lower Road and then straight ahead to the picnic area.



TECH TIP FROM JERRY ON V8 MOTOR MOUNTS

If you are doing a V8 conversion in a 1960-65 Falcon using original style engine mounts you may not know there is a difference in all 6 pieces . The cast iron frame mounts bolt to the shock towers only one way so I am going to show what the difference is in the intermediate and rubber mounts that complete this setup.



- **1.** These are the intermediate and frame mounts that were used in 1963-65 Falcon V8, notice all 4 pieces have different stud and hole locations, if these are not installed on the correct side the engine will not be sitting in the engine compartment properly. In the picture, the left pieces are the left or driver's side and the right pieces are the right or passenger side.
- **2.** This is the left side rubber mount, the **2220** number is an Anchor brand part number but is used by most manufacturers of this mount. The stud is offset to the front of the car when installed.
- **3.** This is the right side rubber mount, the **2221** number is an Anchor brand part number but is also used by most manufacturers, noticed the stud is also towards the front of the car when installed.
- **4.** This is the left side intermediate mount, the originals are not marked left or right so you have to really be careful to have them on the correct side. The new reproductions that have come out are marked L or R on the one side which makes it easier to figure out.
- **5.** This is the right side intermediate mount, notice the hole location is similar to the left side but the stud location is different.

Because of the support from the aftermarket parts industry, all of the engine mount pieces are available new. <u>Please support the Falcon parts vendors for your parts needs</u>, if we do not support them these parts will go away as this has already with some items. It is expensive upfront cost to reproduce a part and a minimum usually has to be made and if they do not sell well when the time to make another run comes then the part may not be reproduced again.


